


Directions to Sunnybank Farm Cottages

Our postcode for your Satnav is HR1 3DD This will bring you to Venns Green (see last paragraph) If you cannot programme your satnav by postcode you may find you have to use Sutton St Nicholas rather than Venns Green as the village/town. Venns Green is a hamlet within Sutton St Nicholas

Venns Green is situated between Sutton St Nicholas and Bodenham, North East Herefordshire. It is just over a mile from the A417, which runs North West from Gloucester via Junction 2 of the M50. This is the best route if you are coming **from the South**.

From Worcester (and junction 7 of the M5) take the A4103 signed Hereford. 8 miles from Hereford at a set of traffic lights turn right onto the A417 signposted Leominster. Continue for 6½ miles until you come to Bodenham. Just before the turn for Bodenham you will see Brockington Golf Club on your left hand side. 200 yards beyond the golf club turn left signposted for Bodenham Village. Follow this road for 1.5 miles passing through the village of Bodenham until you see the turning to Venns Green on your right.




From Leominster take the A49 south in the Hereford direction. At its junction with Dinmore Caravans and an Esso Garage turn left onto the A417. After 2.5 miles, when you arrive at the village of Bodenham turn right at The England's Gate pub and follow this road for 1.5 miles passing through the village of Bodenham until you see the turning to Venns Green on your right.

From Hereford take the A465 and at the roundabout at the bottom of Aylestone Hill at its junction with the A4103 take the exit signed Sutton St Nicholas and Bodenham. Stay on this road for approximately 4.5 miles passing through the village of Sutton St Nicholas. Once you have passed the Amberley Arms on your left hand side and a turn for Marden then go through three sharp bends and we are the next turning on your left signed Venns Green

Venns Green. Once you have turned onto the road signed Venns Green follow this road for half a mile to the very end. This is a single track road and some of our neighbours have small children and dogs so could we ask that you do not go above 20 mph.

At the very end you will see a sign on a brick pillar in front of you for Sunnybank Farm. Turn left in front of this sign and go along the bridle way for 50 yards and you will see the gates on your right for Sunnybank Farm Cottages.
